

Please refer to the subject cited above.

It is to inform you that after round of meetings under the Chairmanship of Additional Principal Secretary to CM, Haryana on dated 18-09-2015 & 09.10.2015, It was decided that the ORGI/CRS software will be used for Online registration of Births & Deaths in whole State. The launched and implementation of the ORGI software for Online Registration of Births & Deaths will be start from November, 2015 in whole State.

To implement the CRS software for online registration of Births & Deaths using ORGI/CRS software, functionaries may be trained on the usage CRS software for its implementation in each District. These trainings will be imparted to all the Officer/Official controlling Births & Deaths registration work in Rural and Urban Area. The District wise list of number of trainings and estimated number of participants are enclosed herewith at **Annexure-I**.

The participants for the ORGI/CRS software trainings will be from Govt. Medical Institutions, Private Hospitals, all Local Bodies such as: Municipal Council, Municipal Corporation and all military establishments (CBs), Railway Hospitals etc. These participants like; Registrar of Births & Deaths of each registration unit, Information Assistant (IA) of each registration unit, Data Entry Operator (DEO) of each registration unit, Municipal Corporation Staff engaged for Births & Deaths registration/ Computerisation including Aadhaar enrolment, Municipal Councils Staff engaged for Births & Deaths registration/ Computerisation including Aadhaar enrolment, Concerned staff of Private Hospitals engaged for Births & Deaths registration/Computerisation including Aadhaar enrolment etc.



Registrar of Births & Deaths of each registration unit should give a brief introduction/training on the software, Births & Deaths Acts, Rules, and Information form etc to all ANMs and ASHA working under their area.

The overall responsibility for smooth/proper training and its implementation will be done by District Registrar (Births & Deaths) cum Civil Surgeon/Additional District Registrar (Births & Deaths) cum Deputy Civil Surgeon (Health). Moreover they will also provide the brief on Births & Deaths Acts and Rules.

It is therefore requested to direct all the participants to attend the training on fixed date and time for the smooth and proper implantation of ORGI software.


