Agenda for Video Conference to be chaired by Hon'ble CM with all Deputy Commissioners / Municipal Corporation scheduled to be held on 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2016 at 3:00 PM regarding how to tackle stray cattle with all DCs/Commissioners Municipal Corporation

The Govt. is very much aware of the problem concerning stray animals and has initiated many steps to rehabilitate the stray cattle, establishment of Gau Abhyaranyas, castration of scrub bulls, rehabilitating the stray animals in State run Gausadans / Gaushalas & other Gaushalas owned by trusts, are the measures upon which the Govt. is working with its full efforts.

**The District-wise number of stray cattle to be accommodated in the existing Gaushalas is as under:-**

**Proposed strategies to rehabilitate the stray cattle in the Gaushalas:**

- The Grant-in-Aid to the existing registered Gaushalas for creation of additional infrastructure in the form of cattle shelters, fodder store, water and fodder troughs etc so that they are able to house additional stray cattle therein will be provided by the Haryana Gau Sewa Aayog. A first instalment an amount of Rs 15 Lakh be released to each Deputy Commissioner for assisting the existing

Gaushalas for creating addition infrastructure in different Gaushalas in the district for housing the additional stray cattle. The second instalment of Grant-in- Aid of Rs 35 lakh shall be released by the Haryana Gau Sewa Aayog to respective DCs in due course.

- b) Municipal Corporation may hire vehicles for transportation of stray cattle from various places to the nearby Gaushalas of the districts. The help of the concerned Veterinary Surgeon of Veterinary Livestock Development Assistant to take care of health problem/tranquilizing the stray cattle for easy transportation may be obtained by the Municipal Corporation.
- c) The teams of Municipal Corporation personals and the technical staff from Animal Husbandry & Dairying shall be constituted for handling / loading and transportation of the stray animals from various locations to the Gaushalas by the respective Deputy Commissioners.
- d) The Gaushalas will be sensitized to accommodate additional stray cattle by the Haryana Gau Seva Aayog, the officials of Animal Husbandry & Dairying Department and the officials of District administration.
- e) All the animals maintained in the Gaushalas shall be ear tagged by Haryana Gau Seva Aayog with twelve digits Information Network for Animal Productivity and Health (INAPH) number.
- f) The overall supervision of these activities will be done by the concerned Deputy Commissioner in coordination with Superintendent of Police.
