



ORDER

No.MCF/SE/2019/505
Dated: 30/10/19

It has been reported by the field staff of Municipal Corporation, Faridabad that in few areas of Municipal Corporation, Faridabad, especially falling in unapproved area, residents of such areas have septic tanks for storage of their sewage. Such sewage at times is disposed off by them through private septic tankers in open spaces or in storm water drains secretly thereby causing nuisance and health hazards for the citizens of such areas. These acts are not only in sheer violation of the Environment Prevention and Control Act 1974 and Environment Prevention Act, 1986 but are also come within the ambit and scope of the offences punishable under Section 29 (2) of Haryana Municipal Act, 1994. Therefore, in order to deter the said nefarious activities, the Divisional Executive Engineers and Assistant Engineers/ Junior Engineers are hereby directed to look after the work of Septage Management in their respective wards in addition to their present duties with immediate effect.

2. Therefore, in order to sensitize the residents of such areas and as a pilot project, it has been decided to launch as a pilot project to collect septage from individual households falling within MCF limit in order to disposal of the same into the nearest STP @ Rs 450 per tanker and after trial period, suction tanker owners will be empanelled or zone wise annual rate contract will be awarded in due course of law to collect the sewage from the related area/ unapproved colonies for discharging the same into the designated STPs. The charges fixed for this purposes shall be at the rate of Rs 100/- per tanker and in case of failure to do so by a violator, penalty amounting to Rs 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) per tanker shall be imposed on the tankers found to have been disposing sewage at places other than STPs at first detection and with 20% increase in penalty shall be levied on subsequent detections. Besides this, names of violators shall also be sent to Haryana State Pollution Control Board for the purpose of initiating criminal proceedings as well against them.

3. The Assistant Engineers shall ensure that no sewage is disposed off at places other than STPs. The registration no. of violating tankers, name of owner and driver, their mobile number and address shall be noted down alongwith the details of principal originator.

4. Penalty amounting to Rs 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) be imposed on the tankers found to be disposing sewage at places other than STPs at first detection; with 20% hike on subsequent detections. Names of offenders be also sent to HSPCB for the purpose of initiating prosecution process against them. Tankers of the chronic violators be confiscated by virtue of Section-292 (2) of Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994. The challan money shall be kept in a separate account and be utilized for payment towards manpower and other requirements for this system. If additional fund is required for this, that shall be provided by Municipal Corporation, Faridabad keeping in view the importance and sensitivity of the issue towards general public health.

5. All STP in-charge/service providers shall ensure to make sufficient provisions to take sewage through these tankers without making individuals to wait for long time.


6. This order shall be enforced by Assistant Engineers through their Junior Engineers. The Executive Engineer shall monitor the said work; while the Superintending Engineer will hold monthly meeting of all Executive Engineers, Assistant Engineers and Junior Engineers in this regard.
