

Deposit of fee4.
Section 6

(1)The fee shall be deposited with the State Public Information Officer either in Cash against proper receipt, by Bank Draft, by Indian Postal Order or by treasury Challan in the following Heads of Account :—

Major Head	0070—Other Administrative Services
Sub Major Head	60—Other Services
Minor Head	800-Other Receipts
Sub Head	86—Fee under the Right to Information Act, 2005.

Detailed head “0070-Other Administrative Services-60-Other Services-800-Other Receipts-86 Fee under the Right to Information Act, 2005”.

(2) The amount of fee shall be credited to the account as referred in sub-rule (1):

Provided that the Boards, Corporations and other autonomous bodies of the State may get the amount of requisite fee deposited in their own accounts maintained by the.

(3) On receipt of an application, submitted under sub-rule (1) of rule 3, the State Public Information Officer shall scrutinize the application and shall assess how much fee is required to be paid by the applicant for obtaining the information.

(4) The fee assessed under sub-rule (3), shall be intimated to the applicant by the State Public Information Officer, expeditiously, in Model Form ‘B’ to ensure the delivery of information within time specified under sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Act.

Quantum of fee
Section 6 and 7

(1) An application for obtaining any information under Sub-section (1) of Section 6 shall be accompanied with a fee of ten rupees and shall ordinarily not contain more than five hundred words excluding annexure, address of the State Public Information Officer and that of the applicant:

Provided that no application shall be rejected only on the ground that it contains more than five hundred words.

(2) For providing information under Sub-section (1) of Section 7, the fee shall be charged from the applicant at the following rates, namely:-

- (a) two rupees for each page in A-4 or A-3 size paper, created or copied; and
- (b) If information is to be provided on a large size of paper than that of specified in clause (a). the actual cost price of such a paper shall be charged.

(3) For providing information under Sub-section (5) of Section 7, the fee shall be

Charged from the Applicant at the following rates, namely

- (a) fifty rupees for providing information in a floppy.
 - (b) fifty rupees for providing information in. diskette; and
 - (c) if information sought is of such a nature, which is contained in a printed document of which a price has been fixed, then that information shall be provided after charging the price, fixed for that printed document. However, if only an extract or page of such a printed document is asked for, then a fee of two rupees per page shall be charged.
- (4) No fee for inspection of record shall be charged, if such an inspection is made for one hour only. . However, if inspection is made for a period of more than one hour, then a fee of five rupees shall be charged for every subsequent hour or fraction thereof."
