Subject: Financial Terms & Conditions for NIC Portal (etenders.hry.nic.in) for providing e-Procurement Implementation Support to the Government of Haryana.

Whereas the State Government vide its Order No. DS&D/Admin/Single Portal/2014/14460-630 dated 29.01.2015 had decided that all the Government Departments/Boards/Corporations will switch over to online tendering by using the solution by NIC or Nextenders by using the following URLs:

- (i) etenders.hry.nic.in
- (ii) haryanaeprocurement.gov.in , and

Whereas the State Government vide its Order No. 2/2/2016-4IB-II Dated 27.10.2016 laid out the duties/responsibilities of NIC (etenders.hry.nic.in) as managed Service Provider (MSP) Agency and DGS&D as Nodal Department to ensure uniformity of processes to that of Single e-Procurement Portal (haryanaeprocurement.gov.in) , and


Whereas the NIC Haryana informed on 08.03.2019, that sustenance of e-Procurement Implementation Support to the Government of Haryana was extended through NIC/NICSI budget and later on since 2011 as part of e-procurement Mission Mode Project (MMP) under National e-Governance Plan. It had been further informed that MMP Project Period has ended in March 2017 and NIC has been supporting implementation in Government of Haryana with its own resources since then. Now, the NIC has requested that the said services will be provided on payment basis.

The matter has been examined by the State Government and the following has been decided:-

1. In order to maintain uniformity of processes as was provided in Single e-Procurement Portal (haryanaeprocurement.gov.in) and to make these services off-budget/self sustainable, the NIC e-Procurement Portal (etenders.hry.nic.in) will collect an amount of Rs.1000/- as the e-Service Fee payable by the bidder along with its bid. This amount of Rs.1000/- will be non-refundable.
2. The e-Service Fee @ Rs.1000/- per bidder collected as such will be credited into the account of 'Society of IT Initiative fund for e-Governance' where a separate account with the link 'DSD-NIC e-Tender Service Fee Fund' will be maintained. The Society will be responsible for meeting the related expenditure on payment of Service Charges to NIC Haryana, payment obligation for connectivity and Data Center related services, and any fresh investment required to address obsolescence aspects requiring a certain level of operational flexibility. The expenditure on all the above will be incurred based on the advice of DS&D for which the Society may be paid amount for the services rendered in this behalf.
3. Out of the Rs. 1000/- received as e-Service Fee, the NIC Haryana will be paid Service Charges as per the bill raised by them as contained in their proposal dated 08.03.2019 or as amended by them or as decided by the State Government.

The above instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned for compliance.
